This will be held in the parish hall of St. Philip's Episcopal Church, 403 E. Main St., Durham; enter from glass doors facing Queen St. **From I-85**, exit Durham downtown. At the 5th light, turn left on Chapel Hill St. (becomes Liberty St.). Go through the light at Roxboro St. then take the next right at Queen St. The Church is one block ahead at Queen & Main Sts. **From the Durham Freeway**, exit at Roxboro Rd. and turn north toward downtown. Pass under a railroad overpass, then turn right at the next light, Main St. The Church is one block ahead at Queen & Main Sts. **From Chapel Hill**, take 15/501 N toward South Square Mall and stay on 15/501 Business when 15/501 Bypass branches off. At the T, turn left onto University Dr. Go 1.6 miles to a light and turn left onto S. Roxboro Rd. In .5 miles turn right at a light onto Main St.; the Church is just ahead at Main and Queen Sts. **From Raleigh**, route 40 west to Durham Freeway north, then follow directions from the freeway.
